### H2HA Scholarship Award Criteria

H2HA (Heart to Heart Anatolia) is a non-profit organization which was founded with the primary objective of supporting efforts for preserving the key elements of Anatolian culture and the associated social values. As such, it seeks applicants who are or have high potential to become leaders to pursue the stated objective. The applicants must be willing to contribute for this objective once they complete their studies which should be directly, or in some exceptional cases indirectly, related to elements of Anatolian culture. The following criteria are desirable but not limiting:

Being born in Turkiye (Turkey)

Having a family background that has strong bonds and originates from the rural areas of Anatolia

Proof of good academic standing

Need for financial support

Ambition for higher education

Interest to pursue higher education relevant to Anatolian culture in the areas including but not limited to: history, music, religion, general art, anthropology or similar.

Excellent references
